



Materials:

Cards
minute timer
candle or flashlight

Rules: Print cards on the next pages on cardstock and cut them out. Turn down lights and sit in a circle. Put candle or flashlight in the center of the circle. Shuffle cards. Give all cards to the youngest family member, face down, and have him or her pick one card. Beginning with that prompt, he or she gets to tell a story for one minute. When the time is up, the family member to the left is given the cards. He chooses one, then continues the story from that prompt for one minute. When his minute is up, he passes the cards to the left and so on. Each person should repeat the last line spoken by the previous person so the story keeps going. The game ends when the last person has taken a turn, when the cards run out or when everyone has had enough of it.
