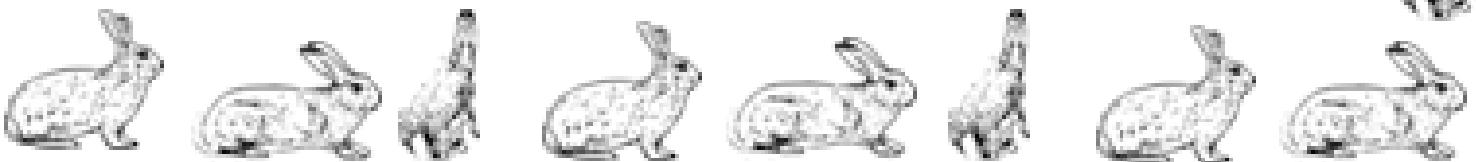
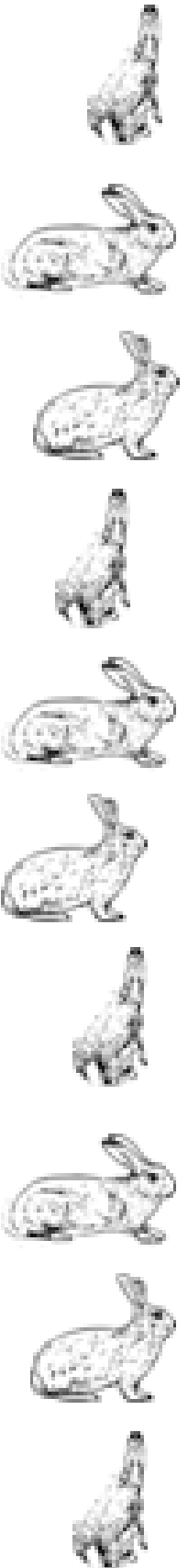
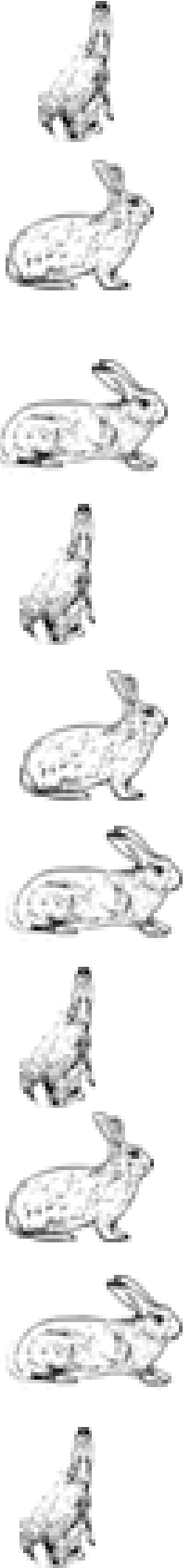




Watership Down Scavenger Hunt

Dear Parent or Educator,

This Watership Down Scavenger Hunt is created from names and items found throughout Richard Adams' novel *Watership Down*. Read all or part of the book with your children so they have an idea where the items come from.

Give each child a copy of the scavenger hunt to take with them on a walk. Have them check off the items as they spot them. It is not necessary to find every single item. There may not be a rainbow on the day you do your hunt or you may not be near a river or stream.

Most of the rabbits in the novel are named after plants, so you could include a fun plant study with the scavenger hunt if you wish.

The point of this activity is to engage your children in what they are reading with outdoor, active play.

You can reward the child who finds the most items, or let the finding be the reward. Your children will have fun either way, so it is up to you.

Most of all, have fun. Talk with your children about the items and relate them to the story. You'll be surprised at how much they will remember after they've had fun with the book.
